अरीळह *a.* (= अरीढ) Ved. Not licked; अरीळहं वत्सं चरथाय माता Rv. 4. 18. 10.

अरुः 1 The sun. -2 N. of a plant (रक्तखदिर).

अरुंषिका [अरुंषि मर्मस्थानान्यधिकृत्य जाता] Scab on the head (Mar. खवडे) Suśr.

अरुच *a.* Ved. Lightless, dark; अयं रोचयदरुचो रुचानो Rv. 6. 39. 4.

अरुचिः *f.* 1 Aversion, dislike in general; क सा भोगानामुपर्यरुचिः K. 146. -2 Want of appetite, disrelish, disgust; सन्निपातक्षयश्वासकासहिकारुचिप्रणुत् Suśr. -3 Absence of a satisfactory explanation.

अरुचिर, अरुच्य *a.* Disagreeable, disgusting.

अरुण *a.* Not broken, not diseased, sound. रुजदरुणं वि वलस्य साउम् Rv. 6. 39. 2.

अरुण *a.* (-णा, -णि *f.*) [ऋ-उनन्; cf. Up. 3. 60] 1 Reddish brown, tawny, red, ruddy (of the colour of the morning as opposed to the darkness of night); प्रत्याख्यातविशेषकं कुरबकं श्यामावदातारुणम् M. 3. 5; नयनान्यरुणानि घूर्णयन् Ku. 4. 12. -2 Perplexed, embarrassed. -3 Dumb. -णः 1 Red colour, the colour of the dawn or morning twilight. -2 The dawn personified as the charioteer of the Sun; आविष्कृतारुणपुरःसर एकतोऽर्कः S. 4. 2, 7. 4; विभावरी यद्यरुणाय कल्पते Ku. 5. 44; R. 5. 71. [Aruṇa is represented as the elder brother of Garuḍa, being the son of Vinatā by Kaśyapa. Vinatā prematurely hatched the egg and the child was born without thighs, and hence he is called Anūru 'thighless', or Vipādu 'footless'. He cursed his mother that since she had brought him forth before the due season she would be a slave to her rival Kadrū; but at her earnest entreaties, he modified the curse and said that her next son would deliver her from bondage. Aruṇa now holds the office of the charioteer of the Sun. अरुणीयः, -योगः The 25th Upaniṣad of the Atharvaveda.

अरुद्ध *a.* Not hindered.

अरुत *a.* Ved. Not to be broken.

अरुतुद् *a.* [अरुंषि मर्माणि तुदति; अरुस्-तुद्, खश् सुमागमश्च विध्वरुषोस्तुदः P. III. 2. 35; अरुद्विषदजन्तस्यमुम् VI. 3. 67] 1 Cutting or wounding the vital parts, inflicting wounds, corrosive, painful, sharp (fig. also); caustic; अरुतुदमिवाला नमनिर्वाणस्य दन्तिनः R. 1. 71; Ki. 14. 55; Si. 2. 109. -2 Acrimonious, sour (disposition); नारुतुदः स्यादातोऽपि Ms. 2. 161.
