आप्यायित a. 1 Satisfied, pleased. -2 Improved; grown, increased. -3 Stout, fat, robust.

आप्याय्य a. To be satisfied or pleased.

आप्र a. Ved. [आ-प्र-मूल^० क] 1 Filling. -2 Able to reach (Sāy.). -3 Busy, zealous.

आप्रच्छ 6 Ā. 1 To bid adieu, bid farewell; आपृच्छस्व प्रियसखममुं तुङ्गमल्लिङ्ग्य शैलम् Me. 12; R. 8. 49, 12. 103; Mā. 7; Bk. 14. 63. -2 To salute on receiving, but particularly parting with a visitor (साधो यामि इति वचनम्) -3 To ask. -4 To extol. Irregularly it is used in Parasmaipada also; cf. आपृच्छ पुत्रकृतकान् हरिणान् दुर्माश्व Pratimā. 5. 11.

आपृच्छा [प्रच्छ-अच्] 1 Conversation. -2 Bidding farewell. -3 Curiosity.

आपृच्छय pot. p. 1 To be saluted, welcomed or honoured. -2 Praiseworthy, commendable. -3 Beautiful.

आपृष्ट a. 1 Welcomed, saluted. -2 Asked for. नापृष्टः कस्यचिद् ब्रूयात् Mb.

आप्रच्छनम् 1 Bidding adieu, taking leave at the time of departure. -2 Welcoming, hailing.

आप्रच्छन्न a. Secret, hidden.

आप्रदिवम् ind. Forever.

आप्रपदम् [प्रपदं पदाग्रं तत्पर्यन्तं अव्ययी^०] A dress reaching to the feet. -ind. To the end of the foot, reaching to the feet.

आप्रपदीन a. [आप्रपदं व्याप्नोति ख] Reaching to the feet (as dress); भाति रस दामाप्रपदीनमस्य Śi. 3. 10; K. 130; (आप्रपदीनकम् also).

आप्रवण a. Slightly humble or precipitous.

आप्री f. [आप्रीणाःत्यनया आ-प्री-ड-गौरा^० ङीप्] Ved. 1 Conciliation, propitiation, gaining one's favour. -2 (pl.) ' Propitiatory verses ', a name given to certain invocations addressed to several deified objects in consecutive order, and said to be introductory to the animal sacrifice; some take the *Apris* to represent the objects themselves, the verses being consequently called *Apris* verses. The objects invoked are 12:—Susamiddha, Tanūnapāt, Narāsaṁsa, the divine being bearing invocations to the gods, Barhis, the doors of the sacrificial chamber, night and dawn the two divine beings protecting the sacrifice, the three goddesses Ilā,

Sarasvatī, and Mahī, Tvaṣṭri, Vanaspati and Svāhā, (all these being regarded by Sāyana to be different forms of Agni); स एता आप्रीरपश्यताभिर्वै स मुखत आत्मानमाप्रीणीत; cf. also Max Muller's Hist. Anc. Lit. pp. 463-466.

आप्रीतपः, -पाः N. of Viṣṇu (protecting those who have appeased his anger).

आप्लु 1 Ā. 1 To jump up, dance, spring; आप्लुय पदान्यद्यौ Mb.; (रथं) आप्लुवे सिंह इवाचलाग्रम्. -2 To bathe, wash, immerse oneself (fig. also); प्रयागे आप्लुय गात्राणि Mb.; आप्लुत्याकाशगङ्गायाम् *ibid*; Ms. 7. 216, 11. 202. -Caus. (प्लावयति) 1 To cause to be washed or bathed; आप्लावयत गात्राणि Mb. -2 To wash, wet, sprinkle; अन्माप्लाव्य वारिण Ms. 3. 244, 11. 98. -3 To overflow, overwhelm, inundate, flood over. -4 To set in, commotion. -5 (Ātm.) To bathe.

आप्लवः, -प्लवनम् 1 Bathing, immersing. -2 Sprinkling with water (on all sides). -Comp. -व्रतिन् or **आप्लुतव्रतिन्** m. a householder who has passed through the first order (ब्रह्मचर्य) and is admitted into the second (गार्हस्थ्य), an initiated householder; cf. स्नातक.

आप्लावः 1 Bathing, immersing, -2 Sprinkling, wetting. -3 Submerging. -4 A flood, an inundation; प्रलयाप्लावमिवाभिदर्शयन्तः Śi. 20. 70.

आप्लुत p. p. 1 Bathed; अवभृथाप्लुतो मुनिः R. 11. 31; Ku. 6. 5. ततः समुत्सुकोऽभ्येत्य नृपतिर्दुतमाप्लुतः Śiva. B. 1. 79. -2 Wetted, sprinkled; यावन्नादयायते वेदिरभिषेकजलाप्लुता R. 17. 37. -3 Overflowing with, filled or overcome with; बाष्प^०, व्यसन^०, रुधिर^० &c. -4 Possessed by, eclipsed; अवाङ्मुखमथो दीनं दृष्ट्वा सोममिवाप्लुतम् Rām. 7. 106. 1. -तः, ^०व्रती An initiated householder, see आप्लवव्रतिन्. -तम् Bathing.

आप्लुष्ट a. A little singed or burnt; दिवाकराप्लुष्टविभूषणास्पदाम् Ku. 5. 48.

आप्वा The neck.

आफलकः Enclosure, palisade; वार्याफलकपर्यन्तां पिबन्निक्षुमती नदीम् Rām. 1. 70. 3.

आफीनम् An Opium.
