**आश्म** *a.* (-श्मी *f.*) [अश्मन-अण्] Made of stone, stony. -**श्मः** Anything made of stone. -**Comp.** -**भारिक** *a.* having a mass of stones. -**रथ्यः** N. of a teacher of ritual.

**आश्मन** *a.* (-नी *f.*) [अश्मनो विकारः अण्] Stony, made of stones. स चापमारमनप्रख्यं सेषु धत्तेऽन्यदुर्वहाम् Bk. -**नः** 1 Anything made of stone. -2 N. of Aruna, the chariot-  
teer of the sun.

**आश्मरिक** *a.* (-की *f.*) [अश्मयेव स्वार्थे बा<sup>०</sup> ठञ्] Suffering from stone in the bladder. -**कः** N. of a disease (अश्मरी *q. v.*).

**आश्रपणम्** [आ-श्रा-णिच् ल्युट्] The act of cooking or boiling.

**आश्रम्** [अश्रमेव, स्वार्थेऽण्] Tear.

**आश्रमः, -मम्** [आ-श्रम् आधारे घञ् वृद्धपभावः] 1 A hermitage, hut, cell, dwelling or abode of ascetics; शरणान्यशरणानि आश्रमाणि कृतानि नः Rām. 7. 6. 5. -2 A stage, order, or period of the (religious) life of a Brāhmaṇa (These are four:--ब्रह्मचर्यं the life of a student; गृहस्थ्य the life of a house-holder; वानप्रस्थ the life of an anchorite or hermit, and संन्यास the life of a Bhikṣu or beggar. Kṣatriyas (and Vsiyas also) can enter, upon the first three Āśramas; cf.
