इलिका 1 The earth. -2 The middle arch of a niche; Gīrvāna.

इलिनी *N.* of the daughter of मेधातिथि.

इली [इल्-क ङीष्] A cudgel, a stick shaped like a sword, a short sword (करवाल).

इलीबिशः *N.* of a demon conquered by Indra; न्याविध्यदिलीबिशस्य दृहळा Rv. 1. 33. 12.

इलीशः, इल्लिशः A sort of fish, commonly hilsa or sable. इलीशोचितपीयूषो वाचा वाचामगोचरः Udb.

इल्यः *N.* of a mythical tree in the other world; स आगच्छतीत्यं वृक्षम् Kauṣ. Up. 1. 5.

इल्वकाः, -लाः (*pl.*) *N.* of the five stars in the head of Orion (मृगशिरस्).

इव *ind.* 1 Like, as (showing उपमा or comparison); वागर्थाविव संप्रुक्तौ R. 1. 1; वैनेतेय इव विनतानन्दनः K. 5. -2 As if, as it were (denoting उत्प्रेक्षा); पर्यामीव पिनाकिनम् Ś. 1. 6. लिम्पतीव तमोङ्गानि वर्षतीवाञ्जनं नभः Mk. 1. 34. -3 Little, somewhat, perhaps; कडार इवायम् G. M. -4 (Added to interrogative words), 'Possibly', 'I should like to know', 'indeed'; विना सीतादेव्या किमिव हि न दुःखं रघुपतेः U. 6. 30; क इव of what sort, what-like; क इव कालः Māl. 2; what a long time has elapsed. -5 इव is frequently used with adverbs, especially with such as involve restriction, by way of emphasis in the sense of even or just so, just, exactly, quite, indeed, very; मुहुर्नमिव but for a moment; किंचिदिव just a little bit; so ईषदिव, नात्रिरादिव, &c.; (इव is considered by grammarians as forming compounds with the word after which it stands; इवेन समासो विभक्त्यलोपश्च Vart. on P.
