उत्सोद्य a. High, tall. -द्यः 1 A height, elevation; (fig. also); पयोधरोत्सोद्यविशीर्णसंहति (बल्कलम्) Ku. 5. 8, 24. cf. also Kau. उत्सिमयः Smile. -a. Open, blooming.

उत्सिमतम् Smile; Bhāg.

उत्स्य a. Coming from a well or fountain (as water); Av. 19. 2. 1.

उत्स्रोतस a. Having the flow (of life) upward; opposed to अवस्रोतस्.

उत्सवन a. High-sounding. -नः A loud sound.

उत्सव्णायते Den. Ā. To talk in one's sleep, dream through uneasiness; सीतोत्सव्णायते U. 1; साम्प्रतं मालविकासु-त्सव्णायते M. 4.

उद् ind. A prefix to verbs and nouns. G. M. gives the following senses with illustrations:- (1) Superiority in place, rank or power; up, upwards, upon; on, over, above (उद्बल). (2) Separation, disjunction उत्कञ्चुकः; out, out off, from, apart &c.; उद्गच्छति. (3) Motion upwards (उत्कन्धरः; उत्पताक, उत्तिष्ठति) पुरन्दर-श्रीः परमुत्पताकं प्रविश्य पौरैरभिनन्द्यमानः R. 2. 74. (4) acquisition, gain; उपार्जति. (5) Publicity; उच्चरति. (6) Wonder; anxiety; उत्सुक. (7) Liberation; उद्गत. (8) Absence; उत्पथ. (9) Blowing, expanding, opening; उत्फुल्ल. (10) Pre-eminence; उद्दिष्ट. (11) Power; उत्साहः; उन् प्राबल्यवियोगोर्ध्वकर्मलाभप्रकाशाश्चर्यमोक्षणाभावदलप्राधान्यशक्तिषु.
