Kṛiṣṇa was taken by Akṛūra to Mathurā, Uddhava  
was implored by the citizens of Gokula to go and fetch  
him. He was very much attached to Kṛiṣṇa. On see-  
ing the destruction of the Yādavas to be inevitable, he  
went to Kṛiṣṇa and asked him what to do; whereupon  
he was told to go to Badarikāśrama to practise penance  
and to secure heaven. He is the subject of two short  
poems, उद्धवदूत and उद्धवसंदेश.

उद्धस्त *a.* Extending or raising the hands.
