(P. epic.) 1 To be grieved or afflicted, be agitated; नोद्विजेत्प्राप्य चाप्रियम् Bg. 5. 20; tremble, shake (lit. and fig.). -2 To fear, be afraid of, shrink from, abhor (with abl.); तीक्ष्णादुद्विजेते Mu. 3. 5; Bg. 12. 15; लोकापवादानोद्विजम् K. 197; नायमुद्विजितुं कालः स्वामि-कार्यात् Bk. 7. 92. -3 To be tired or sick of, be disgusted with; जीवितादुद्विजमानेन Mal. 3; sometimes with gen. या ममोद्विजते नित्यं साद्य मामवगृहते Pt. 4. 76. -4 To grieve, afflict, frighten. -Caus. 1 To trouble, harass, afflict, oppress; उद्विजयत्यङ्गुलिपारिणभागान् Ku. 1. 11.; उद्विजिता वृष्टिभिः 5; म्लेच्छैस्तेज्यमाना Mu. 7. 19. -2 To terrify, frighten; उद्विजिताः कृजितैः U. 2. 29. -3 To produce disgust or abhorrence; रमणीयाप्युद्विजयति K. 12; सीधुपानोद्वि-जितस्य M. 3; Ś. 2. -4 To revive a fainting person (by sprinkling water) Suśr.

उद्विग्न p. p. 1 Grieved, afflicted, sorrowful, anxious (as for any absent lover); चित्त, -चेतस् -मनस्-हृदय depressed in mind, sorry, anxious. -2 Alarmed, frightened; U. 4. -दृश f. -लोचनम् A frightened glance.

उद्वेग a. [उद्वतो वेगोऽस्मात्] 1 Going swiftly (as an express messenger), courier. -2 Steady, calm, tranquil. -3 Ascending, mounting. -4 One whose arms by long practice continue always raised above the head (as an ascetic). -गः 1 Trembling, shaking, waving. -2 Agitation, excitement; हर्षामर्षभयोद्वेगैर्मुक्तो यः स च मे प्रियः Bg. 12. 15. -3 Alarm, fear; शान्तोद्वेगस्तिमितनयनं दृष्ट्वाक्तिर्भवान्या Me. 38; सहस्रोद्वेगमियं व्रजेदिति R. 8. 7. -4 Anxiety, regret, sorrow, distress (caused by separation from one's favourite object). निवसन्त्यत्र राजेन्द्र गतोद्वेगा निरुत्सुकाः Mb. 3. 173. 14. -5 Admiration, astonishment. -गम् A betelnut (fruit). -Comp. -कर, -कारक, -कारिन् a. Causing anxiety, agitation or distress; Pt.

उद्वेजि (गि) न्, -जक a. 1 Agitating, distressing, causing pain or distress. -2 Suffering distress, anxious, unhappy.

उद्वेजन a. Causing to tremble (with fear); hurting the feelings. -नम् 1 Agitation, anxiety. -2 Infliction of pain, torture, affliction; उद्वेजनकरैर्दण्डैश्चिह्नयित्वा प्रवासयेत् Ms. 8. 352 painful. -3 Regret, sorrow for one's absence. -4 Shudder, shuddering; Suśr.

उद्वेजयित् a. Terrifying; अत्यर्थमुद्वेजयिता परेषाम् Śi. 3. 19.

उद्विवर्हणम् Rescuing, lifting; plucking up; Bhāg. 3. 13. 43. रसां गताया भुव उद्विवर्हणम् (v. 1. उद्विवर्हणम्).

उद्वीक्ष् [उद्-वि-ईक्ष्] 1 A. To look up, view, see, perceive; दृष्टिरधिकं सोत्कण्ठमुद्वीक्षते Amaru. 28; प्रियस्य पदवीमुद्वीक्ष्य 76 looking at (waiting for); R. 13. 68. -2 To examine, consider; आत्मनः शक्तिमुद्वीक्ष्य Pt. 1. 236.

उद्वीक्षणम् 1 Looking up or upwards. -2 Sight, an eye; seeing, looking at; सखीजनोद्वीक्षणकौमुदीमुखम् R. 3. 1.

उद्वीज् 10 P. 1 To fan. -2 To blow upon or towards.

उद्वीजनम् Fanning.

उद्वृंहणम् Increase, growth; M. W.

उद्वृत् 1 A. 1 To go upwards, ascend. -2 To fly asunder, burst out; उद्वर्तमानमूलबन्धनम् U. 4 the strings of which are giving way or being snapped. -3 To tumble over, fall down. -4 To go out, depart. -5 To rise, swell, increase. -6 To be puffed up with pride, be haughty. -Caus. 1 To extirpate, eradicate, destroy; उद्वर्तितं रसान्तरेण लज्जालुत्वम् Mv. 2. -2 To throw up, elevate. -3 To turn round, roll (as eyes). -4 To anoint, smear. -5 To beat to pieces, split, burst; अपां फेनेन नमुचेः शिर इन्द्रोद्वर्तयः Rv. 8. 14. 13.

उद्वर्त a. 1 Superfluous, redundant, plentiful. -2 Left over as a remainder, surplus. -तैः 1 A remainder, surplus. -2 Excess, preponderance. -3 Rubbing or smearing the body with perfumes. -4 The time of destruction of the world (प्रलयकाल); उद्वर्त इव सत्त्वानां समु-द्राणामभूत्स्वनः Rām. 6. 44. 18.

उद्वर्तक a. 1 Causing to rise. -2 Rubbing and cleaning the body. -कः (In Math.) The quantity assumed for the purpose of the operation (Colebrooke).

उद्वर्तनम् 1 Going up, rising. -2 Springing up, growth (of plants, grain &c.) -3 Prosperity, elevation. -4 Turning from side to side; springing up, popping the head; चटुल्लशफरोद्वर्तनप्रेक्षितानि Me. 42. -5 Grinding, pounding. -6 Drawing out metal, wire-drawing. -7 Anointing, smearing; करोद्वर्तनार्थं चन्दनं समर्पयामि; cf. also सायण's commentary on the Śatapatha Brāhmaṇa 12. 8. 3. 16. - सर्वसुरभिचन्दनादि उन्मर्दनं उद्वर्तनं यजमानस्य भवति। -8 Particularly, rubbing and cleaning the body with perfumes or fragrant unguents, or the unguents used for this purpose or to relieve pain; नाक्रामेद्रक्तविष्मूत्रघ्नोद्वर्तनादि च Y. 1. 152; Ms. 4. 132 (अभ्य-ङ्गमलापकर्षणपिष्टकादि Kull.). उद्वर्तित a. 1 Risen, elevated. -2 Sprung up, drawn out. -3 Perfumed, scented, rubbed, kneaded.

उद्वृत्त p. p. 1 Raised, elevated (स्तन, दन्त, मेघ &c.). गर्जन्तमुद्वृत्तशिताग्रदंष्ट्रम् Rām. 6. 59. 95. -2 Flowing out, not contained in, swollen, overflowing; हृदयभरितोद्वृत्त-विस्मय Mal. 4; अपामुद्वृत्तानाम् Mu. 3. 8 overflowing; उद्वृत्तः क इव सुखावहः परेषाम् Śi. 8. 18. (where उ° means also 'gone astray, ill-behaved'). -3 Grown, increased. -4 Exalted, prosperous. -5 Proud, furious, haughty; परिधत्त किमुद्वृत्ता राजद्रव्याभ्यभीसथ Bhāg. 10. 41. 35. °मृगपति K. 90. -6 Vomited up. -7 Left as a remainder. -8 Ill-conducted, ill-mannered, rude. -9 Agitated;
