(Av. 10. 10. 26). They are the authors or seers of the Vedic hymns; ऋषयों मन्त्रद्रष्टारी विसिष्ठादयः ; or, according to Yaska, यस्य वाक्यं स ऋषि:, i. e. they are the persons to whom the Vedic hymns were revealed. In every Sukta the স্কাৰ্থ is mentioned along with the देवता, छन्दस् and विनियोग. The later works mention seven Risis or saptarsis whose names, according to Sat. Br., are गौतम, भरद्वाज, विश्वामित्र, जमदमि, वसिष्ठ, करयप and अत्रि; according to Mahābhārata, मरााचि, अत्रि, अङ्गिरस्, पुलह, ऋतु, पुलस्त्य and वासेष्ठ; Manu calls these sages Prajapatis or proof mankind, and gives ten names, three more being added to the latter list, i. e. दक्ष or प्रचेतस्, भृगु and नारद.
