एर (ल) ङ्गः A kind of fish.

एरण्डः The castor-oil plant; (a small tree with a scanty number of leaves); and hence the proverb: निरस्तपादपे देशे एरण्डोऽपि दुमायते. -ण्डा Long pepper. -*Comp.* -*पत्रिका*, -*फला* the plant Croton Polyandrum (दन्तीवृक्ष).

एरु a. Ved. Going.
