was he impressed with the power inherent in Brahmanism that he devoted himself to the most rigorous austerities till he successively got the titles Rajarşi, Rişi, Maharşi, and Brahmarşi, but he was not contented till Vasistha himself called him by the name Brahmarsi, which, however, took place after several thousands of years. Viśvāmitra several times tried to excite Vasistha-for example by killing his one hundred sons-but the great sage was not in the least perturbed. His power, even before he finally became a Brahmarsi, was very great, as was seen in his transporting Trisanku to the skies, in saving Sunahsepa from the hands of Indra, in creating things after the style of Brahman &c. &c.
