**परतस्** *para+tas*, adv. **१.** =abl. of *para*, e.g. *paratas-paras*, Higher than the highest, Kumāras. 2, 14; *sra-kāt parato rā gehāt*, From his own house or that of another, Bhāg. P. 1, 18, 25. **२.** Further, Rām. 2, 15, 5 Gorr. **३.** With abl. a. After, Yājū. 2, 173. b. Over, Bhag. 3, 42.

**परता** *para+tā*, f. **१.** Absoluteness, Bhāshāp. 7. **२.** Highest degree, Rājat. 5, 377.—**Comp.** *Tad-para+tā*, f. intentness, Hit. iv. d. 36.

**परत्र** *para+tra*, adv. In the other world, Man. 3, 275. **परत्राय** *para-trāya*, To the other world, MBh. 13, 7688.

**परत्व** *para+tra*, n. **१.** Condition of being more extensive (as a genus), Bhāshāp. 7; comprehensive. **२.** Length of distance and time, Bhāshāp. 120.

**परदारिन्** *paradārin*, i. e. *para-dāra+in*, m.—An adulterer, Rām. 3, 57, 20.

**परंतप** *paramāntapa*, i. e. *para+m-tap+a*, adj. subst. Vexing the foe, Bhag. 4, 2. A conqueror.

**परपुष्ट** *para-pushṭa* (vb. *push*), m. The Cocila or Indian cuckoo, Rām. 3, 78, 29. f. *fā*, Its female.

**परभागता** *para-bhāga+tā*, f. Excellence, supremacy, Ragh. 5, 70.

**परभृत** *para-bhrīta* (vb. *bhṛi*), m. The Cocila or Indian cuckoo, Çāk. d. 85.

**परम** *para+ma*, I. superl. of *para*, f. *mā*. **१.** Most excellent, Man. 1, 108; best, 4, 14. **२.** Highest, Man. 9, 319. **३.** Extreme, 8, 302. **४.** Worst, Brāhmaṇav. 1, 15. **५.** With *chetas*, All (the heart), Rām. 2, 34, 36. **६.** With an abl. it has the signification of the comparat., More excellent, superior, worse; *ko nyo sti paramah civāt*, Who is higher than Ciwa, MBh. 13, 793. **II.** *paramum*, adv.
