and वलभी *valabhi*, f. 1. The wooden frame of a thatch, a roof, Megh. 39 (d). 2. A temporary building on the top of a palace, a turret, Mālay. d. 33 (*valabhi*).

वडवा *vaḍava*, see *baḍavā*.

वडा *vaḍā*, f. Pulse ground and fried with oil or butter (cf. *vaṭa*).

वडिका *vaḍika*, i. e. *vaḍā + ka*, f. Pulse ground and fried, Lass. 79, 14.

वडिञ्ज *vaḍiṅga*, n., and f. *ṣi*, A fish-hook, Bhartr. 1, 84.

वड्ज *vaḍja*, adj. Large.

† वण् *VAN*, वण् *BAN*, i. 1, Par. To sound.

वणिञ्ज् *vaṇiṅga*, see *baṇiṅga*.

वण्ट् *VANT*, i. 1 and 10, To partition, Böhtl. Ind. Spr. 985.—Cf. *vaṇḍ*.

वण्ट् *vaṇṭ + a*, m. 1. A part. 2. The handle of a sickle.

वण्टक *vaṇṭa + ka*, m. A part.—Comp. *Hrid-*, m. the stomach.

वण्टन *vaṇṭ + ana*, n. Dividing, Châp. 5 in Berl. Monatsb. 1864, p. 407.

† वण्ट् *VANTH*, i. 1, Âtm. To go without a companion.

वण्ट *vaṇṭha*, m. 1. An unmarried man. 2. A dwarf. 3. A javelin.

वण्टर *vaṇṭhara*, m. 1. A rope for tying a goat. 2. A dog's tail. 3. The sheath that envelops the young bambu.

वण्टाल *vaṇṭhāla*, m. 1. A mode of conflict, the contest of heroes. 2. A boat. 3. A hoc.

वण्ड *vaṇḍa*, I. adj. (A person) whose hands have been cut off. II. f. *ḍā*, An unchaste woman.

वत *vata* (perhaps curtailed *avata*, 2. pl. imperat. of *av*; cf. Prākṛ. *avidhā*, Sch. ad Çāk. 93, 11), indecl. An interjection implying, 1. Sorrow, woe, Çāk. d. 152; Chr. 3, 37. 2. Compassion. 3. Pleasure. 4. Surprise, Kāvya Prāk. 80, 7. 5. A vocative particle.

वतंस *vataṁsa*, i. e. *ava-taṁsa + a*, m.

1. An ear-ring. 2. A crest.

वतोका *vatohā*, i. e. *ava-toka*, f. A cow miscarrying from accident.

वत्स *vatsa*, I. (vb. i. *vas*), m. 1. A calf, Hit. i. d. 29, M.M. 2. i. e. probably **vatas*, = *Féroc*, + *a*, A year. 3. The name of a Rishi, or saint, Man. 8, 116. 4. pl. The name of a people and their country, Chr. 47, 41; 46, 24. II. m., and f. *sā*, Child, Pañch. 169, 25; a term of endearment, Pañch. 130, 4; Vikr. 70, 10; Utt. Rāmach. 8, 9. III. n. The breast.—Comp. *Çri-*, m. 1. Vishṇu. 2. a mark, usually said to be a curl of hair on the breast of Vishṇu or Kṛishṇa, represented by , Johns. Sel. 96, 74. 3. a hole in a wall for felonious purposes.—Cf. *vatsatara*.

वत्सतर *vatsata + ra*, I. m. A steer. II. f. *ri*, A heifer, Man. 11, 137.

वत्सर *vatsa + ra*, m. A year, Pañch. iii. d. 93.

वत्सल *vatsa + la*, I. adj., f. *lā*, Affectionate, loving, Pañch. 222, 14; tender, Utt. Rāmach. 48, 1. II. f. *lā*, A cow anxious for her calf. III. n. Fondness.—Comp. *Vara-*, f. the wife of a father-in-law. *Sakaja-*, adj., f. *lā*, of inborn fondness. Hit. 87, 12.
