कन्द्, **कन्दति**, **कन्ते** roar, neigh, creak, click, cry, lament. C. **कन्दयति** make roar, neigh, etc., also = S. I. **कनिकन्ति**, **कनिकन्ते**, esp. pp. **कनिकत्**, **कनिकदत्** & **कनिकवमान** = S. — **कभि** shout or roar at, call to (also C. & I.), **कव** roar (also C.). **का** call to, invoke, cry, lament. क्रम, **क्रामति**, **क्रमते** (**क्रामति**, **क्रामते**), pp. **क्रान्त** (mostly —° & w. act. mg.) stride, step, walk, go or come to (acc. or loc.); go over, pass, ascend, approach (sex.); surpass, pervade, fill, accomplish; M. proceed well, succeed. C. **क्रमयति** (**क्रामयति**) cause to stride. I. **चक्रमते**, **चक्रम्यते**, & **चक्रमीति** step to and fro, wander, walk, pass. — **अति** step beyond, cross, pass, excel, overcome, pass by, neglect, transgress (abs. or w. acc.); part or escape from, lose, be deprived of (abl.). C. let pass, take no notice of (acc.). **अभ्यति** step beyond or across, pass, excel, overcome, overstep, neglect, transgress. **व्यति** & **समति** the same. **अधि** ascend, mount up to (acc.) **अनु** go on or along, follow; go through, enumerate. **अप** go or pass away; withdraw or fly from (abl.). **अभि** step near, approach, attack, overwhelm; enter, begin, undertake. **समभि** come near, approach. **अव** go away, fly; tread upon, overwhelm (acc.). — **आ** approach, visit, enter, tread upon (acc. or loc.); cling to, grasp, attack, overpower, take hold or possession of

(acc.); undertake, begin (inf.); ascend, mount (mostly M.). **अध्या** attack, seize, occupy. **समा** the same + tread upon, overpower, take hold or possession of (acc.). **उद्** go up or out, depart; escape, fly or withdraw from (abl. or acc.); pass by, neglect. **बुद्** go asunder, part, go away; overstep, transgress, disregard. **उप** come near, approach, enter (acc. or loc.); go against, attack; treat, deal with (acc.); (mostly M.) undertake, begin, be about to (acc., dat., or inf.). **समुप** come near; undertake, begin (M. w. inf.). **नि** enter, step, tread down. **निस्** go out of (abl.), depart, fly, escape. C. cause to step out, expel, lead or take away. **अभिनिस्**, **उपनिस्**, & **विनिस्** go out, come forth from (abl.). **परा** step forward, advance, exert one's self, excel. **परि** walk about (esp. on the stage), circumbulate, walk through, visit; overtake, overcome. **प्र** step forth, set out, go to (acc.), go across, pass; M. deal with (loc.); M. (A.) proceed to, undertake, begin (acc., **अर्थम्**, or inf.). **संप्र** M. proceed to, begin (acc. or inf.). **प्रति** & **अनुप्रति** come back. **वि** go asunder, part, separate; walk through, bestride; move on, advance, proceed, exert one's self; content, fight against (acc.). **अनुवि** M. step after. **निर्वि** step out. **सम्** come together, meet, encounter; go to, enter (acc.), pass from (abl.) to (loc.), go through or across, come near, walk along.
