

*ṣatti* (SII 2), same as *nivartana*.

(SII 1), a sheep-fold; a square measure.

(CII 4), share of the produce.

(IE 8-3), the smallest division of the army.

*ṣatti* (IA 15), an extra land cess.

*ṣatti-bhāga* (CII 4), same as *ṣatti-bhāga*, a share of produce payable to the landlord.

*Ṣattika* (IE 8-3), leader of the *ṣatti*, the smallest division of the army.

*ṣattikā* (CII 4), a share; same as *ṣatti*.

*ṣattikā* (EI 8, 17), same as *tāmra-ṣaṭṭa* or *tāmra-ṣattikā*; a copper plate or copper-plate grant.

(EI 3), a document.

*Ṣattikā-pālaka*, same as *Pustapāla* (*Select Inscriptions*, p. 202).

*ṣaṭṭi-pada* (EI 24), footprints on a slab.

*Ṣattiyāṇaka* (IA 132), official designation of doubtful import; probably, an administrator or document-writer.

*ṣaṭṭolā*, cf. Tamil *ṣaṭṭolai*.

*ṣaṭṭolai* (SII 1), Tamil=Sanskrit *ṣaṭṭolā*; a document.

*Pāṭṭolai* (EI 21, 22), Tamil; official designation; cf. *ṣaṭṭolai*, 'a document'.

*ṣaṭṭolī*, 'a deed of purchase' also 'land purchased by means of a *ṣaṭṭolī*' (*Jour. As. Soc.*, Letters, Vol. XX, p. 205). See Tamil *ṣaṭṭolai*=*ṣaṭṭolā*, 'a document'.

*Ṣaṭṭ-opādhyāya* (HD), a writer or keeper of official documents. See *Rājatarāṅgiṇī*, V. 397.

*Pātusāha* (BL), Indian modification of a Muslim imperial title; same as Persian *Pādshāh*.

*Ṣaṭṭvāri* (IE 8-3), probably Sanskrit *Ṣaṭṭavārika*; the accountant-clerk; a member of the administrative board called *Cauthiyā* in Western India.

*Pāṭy-uparika* (IE 8-2; 8-3; BL), official designation of uncertain implication; possibly indicating 'the head of the department of accounts'; sometimes also called *Mahārāja*, *Mahāsāmanta*, *Mahāpratihāra*, *Mahāpīlupati*, *Pañc-ādhikaraṇ-oparika* and *Purapāl-oparika*, additionally.

*pāukā* (IE 8-5; EI 29), same as Oḍiyā *pāuseri*; tax on the money realised by creditors from debtors.

*paūka* (EI 31), misprint for Pāli *paṭṭha*=Sanskrit *prastha*; a land measure.
