I. then made friends with Namuci and entered into an agreement with him, saying: “I shall not slay thee with anything wet or dry, in the night or in the day.” One day I. beheld a fog and cut off the head of Namuci with foam of water. The severed head of Namuci thereupon pursued I., saying: “O slayer of a friend, O wretch!” I. repaired to Brahmā, who caused him to perform a sacrifice and bathe in *Arūnā* (t.). Thus I. became free from the sin of brahman murder and returned to heaven.
