

Kalā, pl. (*āḥ*) ("minutes," personif.): IX, 2517.—Do.² = Āiva (1000 names¹⁻²).

Kālacakra(h) = Sūrya (the Sun): III, 151.

Kalaça, a serpent. § 564 (Mātaliyop.): V, 103_γ, 3627 (enumeration).

Kālaçaila, a mountain. § 418 (Tīrthayātrāp.): III, 139, 10820, 10823 (passed by Yudhisṭhira, etc., on their way to Gandhamādāna). Cf. Kālaparvata.

Kalaçapotaka, a serpent. § 47 (Sarpanāmak.): I, 35, 1552 (enumeration).

Kalaçī, a tīrtha. § 364 (Tīrthayātrāp.): III, 83, 6050.

Kalaçodara, a warrior of Skanda. § 615_u (Skanda): IX, 45_η, 2574 (C. has *Kalaso*^o).

Kalada, pl. (*āḥ*), a people. § 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9_ν, 370 (only B., C. has *Kalavāḥ*).

Kāladantaka, a serpent. § 63 (Sarpasattra): I, 57, 2147 (of Vāsuki's race).

Kālādhyaksha = Sūrya (the Sun): III, 152.

Kālaghaṭa, a brahman. § 59 (Sarpasattra): I, 53, 2048 (*dvijāḥ*, among the sadasyas at the snake sacrifice of Janamejaya).

Kālaçoshaka, pl. (*°āḥ*), a people. § 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9_μ, 354 (only C., B. has *Kālatoyakāḥ*).

kālajvalana = kālāgni: VII, 3672 (*°sannibhāḥ*), 7427 (*°sannibhāḥ*).

Kālakā, a female Asura. § 445 (Nivātakavacayuddhap.): III, 173, 12203 (*mahāsuri*, mother of the Kālakeyas). Cf. Kālā.

Kālākāksha¹, a Daitya. § 564 (Mātaliyop.): V, 105_δ, 3685 (had been slain by Garuḍa).

Kālākāksha², a warrior of Skanda. § 615_u (Skanda): IX, 45_η, 2571.

Kalakala = Āiva (1000 names¹).

Kālakañja or **Kālakañja**, pl. (*°āḥ*), a tribe of Asuras. § 268 (Varuṇasabhāv.): II, 9, 365 (*Dānavāḥ*, in the palace of Varuṇa; *°k^o* both B. and C.).—§ 445 (Nivātakavacayuddhap.): III, 173, 12198 (in Hiranyapura; *°k^o* both B. and C.), 12208 (the offspring of Kālakā?; *°k^o* both B. and C.), 12211 (destroyed by Arjuna; *°k^o* both B. and C.).—§ 550 (Samayapālanap.): IV, 13, 340 (*°ā ivāsuraḥ*; *°k^o* both B. and C.).—§ 552 (Goharaṇap.): IV, 49_e, 1539 (*Dānavāḥ*, had been vanquished by Arjuna; *°k^o* B., *°k^o* C.).—§ 552_d (Arjuna): IV, 61, 1976 (had been vanquished by Arjuna; *°k^o* B., *°k^o* C.).—§ 561_d (Nara-Nārāyaṇa): V, 49, 1930 (had been vanquished by Nara (i.e. Arjuna); *°k^o* B., *°k^o* C.).—§ 564 (Mātaliyop.): V, 100, 3571 (*Asurāḥ* . . . *Vishṇupadoḍhavaḥ*, in Hiranyapura; *°k^o* B., *k^o* C.). Kālakaṭaṅkata = Āiva (1000 names²).

Kālakavṛkshiya, a muni. § 266 (Çakrasabhāv.): II, 7, 299 (*muniḥ*, in the palace of Indra).—§ 641 (Rājadh.): XII, 82, 3059 (*muniḥ*, instructed Kshemadarçin), 3060, 3118, 3123 (became the *purohita* of Kshemadarçin); 104, 3849, 3858 (instructed Kshemadarçin).

Kālakeya, pl. (*°āḥ*), a tribe of Asuras. § 4 (Anukram.): 1, 1, †162.—§ 11 (Parvasaṅgr.): I, 2, 460.—§ 97 (Amçāvat.): I, 63, 2543 (the offspring of Kālā, four are enumerated).—§ 264 (Sabhākriyāp.): II, 4, 118 (*yathāsūran K^oan devo Vajradharaḥ*, sc. *kampayām āsa*).—§ 364 (Agastyop.): III, 100, 8691, (followed Vṛtra); 101, 8715 (do.).—§ 445 (Nivātakavacayuddhap.): III, 173; 12207, 12209 (in Hiranyapura, cf. Kālakañja, pl.).—§ 570 (Sainyaniryānap.): V, 158, 5379 (*Dānavāḥ*, had been vanquished by Arjuna, cf. § 445).—§ 593 (Abhimanyuvadhap.): VII, 51, 1997 (had been slain by Arjuna).—§ 599 (Jayadrathavadhap.): VII, 128_{ππ}, 5260 (*°sahasrāṇi caturdaça*, do.).—§ 608 (Karna): VIII, 79, †4054 (had been slain by Arjuna), †4056 (*sa-K^oan Asurāḥ*, do.); 89_a, †4561 (*pūrvam devair ajitam K^oaḥ*, sc. Arjuna).—§ 778_b (Samvartta-Maruttiya): XIV, 9, 248 (*pravrajayam K^oan pṛthivyām*, says Indra). Cf. Kālakañja, pl.

Kālakīrti, a prince. § 130 (Amçāvat.): I, 67, 2673 (incarnation of the Asura Śūparṇa).

Kālakoṭi, a tīrtha. § 379 (Tīrthayātrāp.): III, 95, 8513 (visited by Yudhisṭhira on his tīrthayātrā).

Kālakūṭa¹, a poison. § 28 (Amṛtamanthana): I, 18, 1152 (produced by the churning of the ocean, but swallowed up by Āiva).—§ 317 (Arjunābhigamanap.): III, 12, 540 (*bhojane Bhīmasenasya pāpāḥ*—i.e. Duryodhana—*prakṣhepayad viṣamam K^om*, cf. Kālakūṭaka).—§ 599 (Jayadrathavadhap.): VII, 135, 5561 (*pītvā K^om*). Cf. Kālakūṭaka.

Kālakūṭa², a mountain. § 184 (Pāṇḍu): 1, 119, 4637, (crossed by Pāṇḍu on his way to Çataçrṅga).—§ 276 (Jarāsandhavadhap.): II, 20, 793 (passed by Kṛṣṇa, etc., on their way from Indraprastha to Girivraja (Rājagṛha)).—§ 555 (Sainyodyogap.): V, 19, 599 (among the regions which were occupied by Duryodhana's army).

Kālakūṭa, pl. (*°āḥ*), a people, the inhabitants of Kālakūṭa. § 279 (Arjuna): II, 26, 997 (in the north, vanquished by Arjuna on his digvijaya).

Kālakūṭaka, a poison = Kālakūṭa. § 197 (Bhīmasenarasapāna): I, 128, 5008 (*viṣamam*), 5019 (do., Duryodhana poured *K.* into the food of Bhīmasena).

Kālāmra, a tree in the varsha Bhadrāçva.—§ 574_k (Bhadrāçva): VI, 7, 268 (*mahādrumak*), 272 (description).

Kālamukha, pl. (*°āḥ*), a people. § 284 (Sahadeva): II, 31, 1171 (*nara-Rakshasayonayāḥ*, in the south, vanquished by Sahadeva on his digvijaya).

kālānala = kālāgni: I, 2163 (*°vishāḥ*, sc. *sarpāḥ*); III, 10959 (*iva*), 13604 (*°samadyutiḥ*), 14384 (*°samadyutiḥ*); V, 7245 (*°opamam*); VI, †1271 (*°sannibhāni*), 3612 (*°sama-prabham*), 4582 (*°samau*); VII, †4697 (*°sannibhena*, C. has by error *kālānala*), 5755 (*°adyutiḥ*), †5834 (*°sannibhena*), 9116 (*°samam*), 9396 (*°samaprakhyam*); XII, 10247 (*°opamāḥ*); XIII, 851 (*°samadyutiḥ*).
