

Kalā, pl. (*ah*) ("minutes," personif.): IX, 2517.—Do.² = Çiva (1000 names¹).

Kālacakra(h) = Sūrya (the Sun): III, 151.

Kalaça, a serpent. § 564 (Mātaliyop.): V, 103γ, 3627 (enumeration).

Kālaçaila, a mountain. § 418 (Tirthayātrāp.): III, 139, 10820, 10823 (passed by Yudhiṣṭhīra, etc., on their way to Gandhamādana). Cf. Kālaparvata.

Kalaçapotaka, a serpent. § 47 (Sarpanāmak.): I, 35, 1552 (enumeration).

Kalaçī, a tīrtha. § 364 (Tirthayātrāp.): III, 83, 6050.

Kalaçodara, a warrior of Skanda. § 615u (Skanda): IX, 45η, 2574 (C. has *Kalaso*^o).

Kalada, pl. (*ah*), a people. § 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9ν, 370 (only B., C. has *Kalavāh*).

Kāladantaka, a serpent. § 63 (Sarpasattra): I, 57, 2147 (of Vāsuki's race).

Kālādhyaçkha = Sūrya (the Sun): III, 152.

Kālaghaṭa, a brahman. § 59 (Sarpasattra): I, 53, 2048 (*dvijah*, among the sadasyas at the snake sacrifice of Jāmejaya).

Kālajoshaka, pl. (^oah), a people. § 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9μ, 354 (only C., B. has *Kalatoçakāh*).

kālajvalana = kālāgnī: VII, 3672 (^osannibhāh), 7427 (^osannibhāh).

Kālakā, a female Asura. § 445 (Nivātakavacayuddhap.): III, 173, 12203 (*mahāsurī*, mother of the Kālakeyas). Cf. Kālā.

Kālakāksha¹, a Daitya. § 564 (Mātaliyop.): V, 105δ, 3685 (had been slain by Garuḍa).

Kālakāksha², a warrior of Skanda. § 615u (Skanda): IX, 45η, 2571.

Kalakala = Çiva (1000 names¹).

Kālakanja or **Kālakhañja**, pl. (^oah), a tribe of Asuras. § 268 (Varunabhbhv.): II, 9, 365 (*Dānavāh*, in the palace of Varuna; ^okh both B. and C.).—§ 445 (Nivātakavacayuddhap.): III, 173, 12198 (in Hiranyapura; ^okh both B. and C.), 12208 (the offspring of Kālakā[?]; ^okh both B. and C.), 12211 (destroyed by Arjuna; ^okh both B. and C.).—§ 550 (Samayapālanap.): IV, 13, 340 (^oa *ivāsurāh*; ^okh both B. and C.).—§ 552 (Goharanap.): IV, 49η, 1539 (*Dānavāh*, had been vanquished by Arjuna; ^okh B., ^okh C.).—§ 552d (Arjuna): IV, 61, 1976 (had been vanquished by Arjuna; ^okh B., ^okh C.).—§ 561d (Nara-Nārāyanau): V, 49, 1930 (had been vanquished by Nara (i.e. Arjuna); ^okh B., ^okh C.).—§ 564 (Mātaliyop.): V, 100, 3571 (*Asurāh . . . Kālakavr̄kshiya, a muni. § 266 (Çakrasabhāv.): II, 7, 299 (*munīh*, in the palace of Indra).—§ 641 (Rājadhb.): XII, 82, 3059 (*munīh*, instructed Kshemadarçin), 3060, 3118, 3123 (became the *purohita* of Kshemadarçin); 104, 3849, 3858 (instructed Kshemadarçin).

Kālakeya, pl. (^oah), a tribe of Asuras. § 4 (Anukram.): I, 1, 162.—§ 11 (Parvasaṅgr.): I, 2, 460.—§ 97 (Amçāvat.): I, 63, 2543 (the offspring of Kālā, four are enumerated).—§ 264 (Sabhākriyāp.): II, 4, 118 (*yathāsūrān Kōān devo Vajradharaḥ*, sc. *kampayām āsa*).—§ 364 (Agastyop.): III, 100, 8691, (followed Vṛtra); 101, 8715 (do.).—§ 445 (Nivātakavacayuddhap.): III, 173, 12207, 12209 (in Hiranyapura, cf. Kālakirti, a prince. § 130 (Amçāvat.): I, 67, 2673 (incarnation of the Asura Sūparṇa).

Kālakoti, a tīrtha. § 379 (Tirthayātrāp.): III, 95, 8513 (visited by Yudhiṣṭhīra on his tirthayātrā).

Kālakūta¹, a poison. § 28 (Amṛtamanthana): I, 18, 1152 (produced by the churning of the ocean, but swallowed up by Çiva).—§ 317 (Arjunābhigamanap.): III, 12, 540 (*bhojanas Bhimasenasya pāpāh*—i.e. Duryodhana—*prakshēpayad vishāp Kōm*, cf. Kālakūtaka).—§ 599 (Jayadrathavadhap.): VII, 135, 5561 (*pitvā Kōm*). Cf. Kālakūtaka.

Kālakūta², a mountain. § 184 (Pāndu): I, 119, 4637, (crossed by Pāndu on his way to Çataçringa).—§ 276 (Jarāsandhavadhap.): II, 20, 793 (passed by Krṣṇa, etc., on their way from Indraprashtha to Girivraja (Rājagrha)).—§ 555 (Sainyodyogap.): V, 19, 599 (among the regions which were occupied by Duryodhana's army).

Kālakūta, pl. (^oah), a people, the inhabitants of Kālakūta. § 279 (Arjuna): II, 26, 997 (in the north, vanquished by Arjuna on his digvijaya).

Kālakūtaka, a poison = Kālakūta. § 197 (Bhīmasenarāsapāna): I, 128, 5008 (*vishāp*), 5019 (do., Duryodhana poured *K*. into the food of Bhīmasena).

Kālāmra, a tree in the varsha 'Bhadrācva. —§ 574h (Bhadrācva): VI, 7, 268 (*mādrārumāh*), 272 (description).

Kālamukha, pl. (^oah), a people. § 284 (Sahadeva): II, 31, 1171 (*nara-Rākṣasayonāh*, in the south, vanquished by Sahadeva on his digvijaya).

Kālānala = kālāgnī: I, 2163 (^ovishāh, sc. *sarpāh*); III, 10959 (*iva*), 13604 (^osamadyutih), 14384 (^osamadyutim); V, 7245 (^oopanap); VI, 1271 (^osannibhāni), 3612 (^osamā-prabhām), 4582 (^osamaū); VII, 14697 (^osannibhōna, C. has by error *kālānilā*^o), 5755 (^odyutih), 5834 (^osannibhōna), 9116 (^osamām), 9396 (^osamaprakhyām); XII, 10247 (^oopamāh); XIII, 851 (^osamadyutih).

Kālanemi, an Asura. § 130 (Amçāvat.): I, 67, 2703 (*Dānavānām mahābalaḥ*, incarnate as Kāmsa).

Kālanemihan = Vishṇu (1000 names).

Kālāñjara, a mountain. § 372 (Tirthayātrāp.): III, 85, 8198 (*parvatam*). 8199 (with the tīrtha Devahrada).—§ 377
