Kuruvira⁴ = Karna: VIII, 4435 (*Kuru-Pāñdavaravirau*, i.e. Karna and Arjuna).

Kuruvira⁵ = Yudhishṭhira: V, 980.

Kuruviramukhya, dual (^oau) = Arjuna and Karna: VIII, 14925.

Kuruvrddha¹ = Bhishma: IV, 986; V, 4713, 4962 (*Pitāmahā*), †5654 (*Bhō*), 5718; VI, 841 (*Pitāmahā*), 2112 (do.), 2348, 4915 (*Pitāmahā*), 4977 (*Pitāmahā*), 5217, 5766 (*Pitāmahā*), 5823; VII, 115 (*Pitāmahā*); XI, 29 (*Bhō*).

Kuruyodha = Karna: VIII, 4436 (*Kuru-Pāñdavayodhau* = Karna and Arjuna).

Kushmāṇḍa (B. *Kuçmō*), name of a mantra: XIII, 6236, 6242.

Kushmāṇḍaka (B. *Kuçmō*), a serpent. § 47 (Sarpanāmak.): I, 35, 1556.

Kustumbaru, a Yaksha. § 269 (Vaiçravaṇasabhāv.): II, 10, 397 (among the Yakshas in the palace of Kubera).

Kusuma, a companion of Skanda. § 615u (Skanda): IX, 45_s, 2541 (given to Skanda by Dhātr̄).

Kūtāmohana = Skanda: III, 14632.

Kūtara, a serpent. § 47 (Sarpanāmak.): I, 35, 1560.

Kuthāra, a serpent. § 67 (Sarpasattra): I, 57, 2156 (of Dhṛtarāshṭra's race).

Kutīmukha, a follower of Ciiva (?). § 269 (Vaiçravaṇasabhāv.): II, 10, 415 (in the palace of Kubera).

Kuṭṭāparanta, pl. (^oāh), a people. § 574 (Jambūkh.): VI, 9_μ, 356 (only C., B. has *Kunda*^o).

Kuvaläcva (C. *Kubō*), a king of Ayodhyā, the slayer of Dhundhu. § 474 (Mārkandeyas.): III, 201, 13486 (*Ikshvākuḥ . . . Dhundhumāratvam āgataḥ*), 13487.—§ 474b (Dhundhumārop.): III, 201, 13490 (*Ikshvākuḥ . . . Dhundhumāratvam agamat*), 13513 (son of Bṛhadāçva).—§ 475 (do.): III, 202, 13519 (do., father of 21,000 sons).—§ 476 (do.): III, 202, 13520; 203, 13547.—§ 478 (do.): III, 204, 13592, 13593, 13599, 13601, 13604, 13610 (his sons are consumed by Dhundhu), 13613 (*rājarshih*), 13614 (slew Dhundhu with the Brahmāstra and was therefore called Dhundhumāra), 13622, 13623 (had three sons left, Dṛḍhāçva, Kapilāçva, and Candrāçva). Labdhalaksha, a Pāñdava warrior. § 600 (Ghaṭotkacavadhap.): VII, 158_χ, 7012 (brother of Virāṭ).

Ladaka, pl. (^oāh), a people. § 578 (Bhishmavadhap.): VI, 50_π, 2083 (in the army of Yudhishṭhira; only in C., B. has *Dhenukāh*).

Laghantī, a river. § 268 (Varunasabhāv.): II, 9, 375 (among the rivers present in the palace of Varuna; only in C., B. has *Laṅghati*).

***laghiman** ("lightness"). § 705 (Mokshadh.): XII, 303, 11229 (attributes of Čambhu).—§ 707 (do.): XII, 313, 11602 (attributes of Čambhu Prajāpati).—§ 730 (Ānuçasanik.): XIII, 14_{ee}, 1015 (= Ciiva).

Laghu = Ciiva (1000 names²).

Lajjā ("shame," personif.). § 115 (Amçāvat.): I, 66, 2579 (daughter of Daksha and wife of Dharma).

Lakshaṇā, an Apsaras. § 191 (Arjuna): I, 123, 4818 (dancing at the birth of Arjuna).

Lakshmana¹, son of Daçaratha and Sumitrā and brother of Rāma. § 267 (Yamasabhāv.): II, 8, 329 (in the palace of Yama).—§ 323 (Dvaitavanapr.): III, 25, †953 (accompanied Rāma to the forest, cf. § 527).—§ 525 (Rāmopākhyānap.): III, 274, 15878 (son of Daçaratha), 15879 (Sumitrā was the mother of L. and Catrughna).—§ 527 (do.): III, 277, 15945 (*Rāma-L^oau*), 15973 (when Rāma was banished by his father, L. accompanied him), 15976 (*Rāma-L^oau*), 15982.—§ 528 (Sitāharana): III, 278, 16019, 16023, 16024, 16025, 16029, 16031 (L. was sent by Sitā to rescue Rāma, then Sitā was ravished by Rāvana).—§ 530 (Viçvāvāsumokshaṇa): III, 279, 16057 (C. has by error *Laksha*^o), 16060 (do.), 16061, 16063, 16064 (*Rāma-L^oau*), 16074, 16079, 16083, 16092 (*Rāma-L^oau*), L. was seized by Kabandha, who was slain by Rāma).—§ 531 (Rāmopākhyānap.): III, 280, 16099, 16100 (*Rāma-L^oau*), 16114 (the meeting with Sugrīva, etc.).—§ 532 (Sitāsāntvana): III, 280, 16149 (*Rāmo L^oānugataḥ*), 16161.—§ 534 (Hanūmatpratyāg.): III, 282, 16200, 16201, 16204, 16208, 16212, 16213, 16217 (sent by Rāma to Sugrīva), 16227 (*Rāma-L^osannidhau*), 16229, 16259 (*Rāma-L^oau*).—§ 535 (Setubandhana): III, 283, 16317 (Vibhishana was made the friend of L.).—§ 536 (Lāṅkāpraveça): III, 284, 16346 (attacked the southern gate of the city of Lāṅkā).—§ 537 (Rāma-Rāvaṇayuddha): III, 285_β, 16371, 16376 (fought with Indrajit, the son of Rāvana).—§ 538 (Kumbhakarnādivadha): III, 287, 16421 (slew Kumbhakarna with the Brahmāstra), 16431 (fought with Pramāthin and Vajravega).—§ 540 (Indrajidyuddha): III, 288, 16439, 16442 (*Rāma-L^o-Sugrīvāḥ*), 16446 (*cuḍha-lakṣmaṇaḥ*), 16447, 16453, 16459 (fought with Indrajit), 16460 (*Rāma-L^oau*), 16463 (do.).—§ 541 (Indrajidvadha): III, 289, 16465 (*Rāma-L^oau*), 16476, 16481, 16484 (slew Indrajit).—§ 542 (Rāvaṇavadha): III, 290, 16505.—§ 543 (Rāmābhishhekāp.): III, 291, 16546 (C. has by error *Laksha*^o).—§ 599 (Jayadrathavadhap.): VII, 108, 4065 (^oη Rāvaṇīr—i.e. Indrajit—yathā, sc. *yodhayām da*); 142, 5888 (yathā Rāmaṇujenājau Rāvaṇīr—i.e. Indrajit—L^oma, sc. *nihataḥ*, all. to § 541).—§ 746 (Ānuçasanik.): XIII, 74, 3617 (Rāma Daçarathi imparted Brahmā's discourse on kine to L., who while living in the forest imparted it to the rishis).
