Vaishnavāstra ("the weapon belonging to Vishnu"). § 592 (Samçaptakavadhap.): VII, 29, 1272 (employed by Bhagadutta).—§ 592a (do.): Kṛṣṇa has four forms: 1) one, staving on earth, engaged in ascetic austerities; 2) one,

beholding good and evil deeds in the world; 3) one, coming into the world of men and engaged in action; 4) one, reposing in sleep for 1,000 years, and at the end of the 1,000 years granting, upon awakening, excellent boons. The Earth (Pṛthī), knowing that that time had come, asked of him as a boon for [her son] Naraka, that he, possessed of the *Vaishṇavāstra*, should become incapable of being slain by gods and Asuras. The boon was granted. From Naraka, the king of Prāggjyotisha (i.e. Bhagadatta) got this weapon, that may slay even Indra and Rudra: VII, 29, 1284, [1285 (*astram . . . Vaishṇavam*)].

There Rudra seized the sacrificial beast as his share, but having been satisfied by sacrifice he gave up the beast and went by the path of the gods (*devayānena*). From fear of Rudra the gods reserved the best of all shares for him.
