[**Varupaloka**] (“the world of Varuna”). [§ 757 δ (Hastikūta): Gautama said: Next [to *Sūryaloka*] in the abode of king *Varuṇa*, other luminous eternal regions (*lokāḥ*) are found, free from passion, darkness, and sorrow.—Dṛṣṭardhṛṣṭra said: This is the end of those who always perform *cāturmasya* sacrifices, attain to 1,000 sacrifices (*ishtīndam*), and perform *agnikotras* with faith for three years according to the *Vedas*, who bear well the yoke of duty, walk steadily on the way of the righteous, etc.: XIII, 102, 1477 (*Varunasya rājñāḥ sadane*)].

[**Varuṇa-sabhbā-varṇana(m)**] (“description of the palace of Varuna”). § 268 (Lokapālas.). The *sabhbā* of *Varuṇa* has been built by *Vigvakarman* in the water; it is of pure white, and in dimensions similar to those of *Yama*'s. There *Varuṇa* is sitting (“holding the noose of *dharma*”, v. 369) with *Varuṇi*; worshipped by the *Ādityas*, *Nāgas*, *Daityas*, and *Dānavas* (“free from death”, v. 369); likewise the four oceans (v. 370); the rivers, lakes, etc., in their corporeal forms (*deharantah*, v. 376); the aquatic animals, troops of *Gandharvas* and *Apsarases*, and *Sunābha*, the minister of *Varuṇa*; he is surrounded by his sons and grandsons, and *Go* (*Gonāman*), and *Pushkara* (cf. Rām. VII, 23, 28) (II, 9).
