Vasisthasya asramah m. : The asrama of Vasistha (identical with the above?)

A. Location: On the confluence of Niścirā (niści rāsamgame ... tatrāsramo vasisthasya) 3. 82. 120-121. B. Description: Famous in the three worlds (trisu lokesu viśrutah) 3. 82. 121. C. Holiness: By bathing there one got the fruit of performing a Vājapeya sacrifice (tatrābhisekam kurvāņo vājapeyam avāpnuyāt) 3.82.121.

Vasisthasya asramaha m. : The asrama of Vasistha.

A. Location : At Sthanutirtha (also called Sarasvatitirtha) on the eastern bank of the river Sarasvati (āśramo vai vasisthasya sthānutirthe 'bhavan mahān | pūrvataḥ) 9. 41. 4; (apovāha vasistham tu prācīm disam) 9. 41, 34. B. Description: Great (mahant) 9. 41. 4. C. Past event: Sarasvatl carried away Vasistha from his āsrama by withdrawing her bank near it (tena kūlāpahāreņa maitrāvaruņir auhyata) to the other side (west) 9. 41. 27-28; later she carried him back to his side 9. 41. 34. [See Vasisthapavaha Vol. 1, 438 and SarasvatI (Past events 11) Vol. 1, 473-4741

Vasisthasya aśramah m.: The aśrama of Vasistha.

A. Location: Near the western ocean (samudram te samāśritya vārunam ... kāleyāh sampravartanta) 3, 100, 1. B. Past event : (1) The Kāleya demons ate at night the ascetics living in the asrama of Vasistha (vasisthasyāsrame viprā bhaksitās tair durātmabhih) 3. 100. 3; (2) Vasistha

wanted to end his life when his sons, Sakti and the rest, were killed; when he failed to drown himself in the ocean, dejected, he returned to his āsrama 1. 166. 45.

Vasisthasya āśramah m.: The āśrama of Vasistha.

A. Location: On the mountain Arbuda, the son of Himavant (himavatsutam arbudam /... tatrā śramo vasisthasya) 3, 80, 74-B. Holiness: By living there for one night one got the reward of gifting a thousand cows (tatrosya rajanim ekām gosahasraphalam labhet) 3.80.75.

Vasisthasya aśramah m.: The asrama of Vasistha.

Situated near the Badaripācana tirtha (badarīpācanam gacched vasisthasyāśramam prati) 3. 81. 156. [See Badarapacana Vol. 1. 393]

Vasunām āyatanam nt. : Name of a holy resort (temple?) of Vasus.

A. Location: In a holy forest, not very far from the sea and the tirtha known as Śūrpāraka (śūrpārakam dadarśa | tatrodadheh kamcid ati tya desam ... vanam āsasāda) 3. 118. 8-9; (sa tatra ... vasūnām ... āyatanāni tesām dadarša) 3. 118. 8-13. For B. Description and C. Epic event see Bhagasya ayatanam.

Vatikaşanda m. : Name of a place.

To the north of the Videhas (videhān uttaram ca yah): described as famous and truely powerful; nobody approached its gate (eşa vātikasando vai prakhyātah satyavikramah | nābhyavartata yaddvāram videhan uttaram ca yah //) 3.130.13 (However, Ni. on Bom. Ed. 3. 130. 13 takes vātikaşanda to mean 'a collection of lotuses etc. brought
