

*Idhmavāha* (I)—the son of Dṛḍhacyuta and grandson of Agastya; a sage who came to see Parikṣit practising *prāyopaveśa*.

*Idhmavāha* (II)—a son of Agastya; and the adopted son of Kratu; hence Āgastyas are Kratus.

*Idhmajihva*—a son of Priyavrata and Barhiṣmati. Appointed lord of Plakṣadvīpa, which he divided into seven parts among his seven sons, and retired to practise austerities.

*Ina*—a divinity invoked by cowherdesses to protect the neck of the baby Kṛṣṇa.
