Ukāra—the fourth face of Brahmā whence came Tāmasa Manu of copper colour.

Ugra (i)—a Rudra; son of Bhūta and Sarūpā;¹ an Amitābha deva.²

Ugra (ii)—a Marut of the third *gana*.

Ugra (iii)—a son of Yātudhāna; father of Vajrahā.

Ugra (iv)—a manifestation of Śiva, and the presiding deity of *Yajamāna* (*Adhvīsa*):¹ wife Dikṣā and son Santāna;² the seventh name of Mahādeva.³
