

*Gomedam*—another name for the country Śāntabhayam in the Plakṣadvīpa;<sup>1</sup> surrounding the sea of wine and surrounded by sugar-cane juice sea;<sup>2</sup> encircles the Kumuda hill.<sup>3</sup>
