varga 91-93; KB 4, p.2609-2610). The modern Bengali name of this plant  
is ol. Śivadāsa (a Bengali) on Cakradatta, amlapitta 26: kanda =  
vanya ola; ola is acc. to V. 4, p.66 a synonym of sūraṇakanda; vanasū-  
raṇa is mentioned by Ananta 8, 656.
