

अनायासकत (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Prepared easily, done with facility.

अनार्जव (वं) 1. *n.* Crookedness ; duplicity, want of rectitude.

अनारत (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Eternal.

अनरम्भ (म्भः) 1. *m.* Want of a spirit of enterprize. [Sick.]

अनरोग्य (म्य) 1. *n.* Sickness. *a.*

अनार्य (यः-या-यं) *a.* Unworthy.

अनार्यक (क) 1. *n.* Aloe wood.

अनार्यज (जं) 1. *n.* *Idem.* *a.* Vile.

अनार्यतिक (कः) 1. *m.* A medicinal plant, a kind of gentian.

अनालब्ब (म्भः-म्भा-म्भं) *a.* Unsupported, without a prop.

अनालाप (पः-पा-पं) *a.* Silent.

अनालापन (नं) 1. *n.* Silence.

अनावर्ति (र्त्तिः) 2. *f.* Final emancipation or deliverance.

अनाविल्ल (लः-ला-लं) *a.* Clear.

अनावृत (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Open, uncovered, undressed.

अनादृष्टि (दिः) 2. *f.* Drought.

अनाश्रिन् (मी-श्रिनी-शि) *a.* Immortal, imperishable.

अनाश्य (श्यः-श्या-श्यं) *a.* Indestructible, imperishable.

अनाश्रय (थः) 1. *m.* Independence.

अनाश्रित (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Independent, not relying on another.

अनाश्रस् (आन-शूर्पी-श्रत्) *a.* Fasting. Also अनश्रत्.

अनासिक (कः-का-कं) *a.* Noseless.

अनास्था (स्था) 1. *f.* Unfixedness.

अनास्थादित (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Untasted.

अनाहत (तः-ता-तं) *m.f.n.* New and unbleached (cloth). *a.* Unhurt.

अनाहार (रः) 1. *m.* Abstinence.

अनहारिन् (री-रिणी-रि) *a.* Abstaining from, fasting.

अनाज्ञत (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Uncalled.

अनिःक्षण (एः-एा-एं) *a.* Silent.

अनिकेत (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Houseless, helpless.

अनिन्तु (चुः) 2. *m.* A reed (from which pens are formed).

अनिग्रीष्म (एः-एा-एं) *a.* Unuttered.

अनियच्छ (हः-च्छा-हं) *a.* Unrestrained.

अनिच्छ (च्छः-च्छा-च्छं) *a.* Averse from ; indifferent. Also अनिच्छु.

अनिजक (कः-का-कं) *a.* Another's, not one's own.

अनित (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Destitute of.

अनित्य (त्यः-त्या-त्यं) *a.* Transient ; occasional, irregular.

अनित्यक्रिया (धा) 1. *f.* Special act of worship, not a constant one.

अनित्यसम (सः) 1. *m.* Arguing by illustration, not by logic.

अनिदान (नः-ना-नं) *a.* Groundless.

अनिद्र (द्रः-द्रा-द्रं) *a.* Wakeful.

अनिन्दित (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Unreproachable, blameless, pious.

अनिभृत (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Unsteady.

अनिमत् (सा) 1. *m.* A mote, a grain, the smallest particle.

अनिसिष्ठ (षः) 1. *m.* A God ; a fish ; a demon ; a ghost. Also अनिसेष.

अनिषिष्ठाचार्य (यः) 1. *m.* Name of Vrihaspati teacher of the gods.

अनिथत (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Unrestrained.

अनियमित (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Irregular.

अनिराकृत (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Unchecked.

अनिरुद्ध (इः) 1. *m.* Son of Kāma, n. Rope for tying cattle. *a.* Self-willed ; unrestrained ; spying.
