- गार्धि (धिः) 2. *m.* The name of a king, father of *Viswámitra*.
- गार्धि.ज (जः) 1. *m.* A name of *Viswámitra*. So गार्धि.सुतः, &c.
- गार्धि.पुर (रं) 1. *n.* *Kanauj*.
- गार्धि.भ (भः) 3. *m.* *Viswámitra*.
- गार्धेय (यः) 1. *m.* *Idem*.
- गान (नं) 1. *n.* Singing, a song, sound.
- गानिनी (नी) 3. *f.* Orris root.
- गानीय (यः-या-यं) *a.* Musical.
- गान्तु (न्तुः) 2. *m. f.* A traveller.
- गान्ती (न्ती) 3. *f.* A carriage, a cart.
- गान्दिनी (नी) 3. *f.* The river Ganges.
- गान्दिनी.सुत (तः) 1. *m.* *Bhishma*.
- गान्धर्व्व (र्व्वः) 1. *m.* A heavenly chorister. *n.* A song ; form of marriage, requiring only mutual agreement. *a.* Belonging to a *Gandharba*.
- गान्धार (रः) 1. *m.* One of the seven primary notes of music ; red lead ; a country. *n.* Gum, myrrh. *f.* (रो) Wife of *Dhrítaráshtra* ; music.
- गान्धारेय (यः) 1. *m.* *Duryódhana*.
- गान्धिक (कः) 1. *m.* A scribe ; a perfumer ; a kind of worm.
- गामुक (कः-का-कं) *a.* Going.
- गाम्भीर्य्य (र्य्यं) 1. *n.* Depth ; dignity.
- गायक (कः) 1. *m.* A singer.
- गायत्रिन् (त्री) 5. *m.* A tree that yields resin (*Mimosa catechu*).
- गायत्री (त्री) 3. *f.* A sacred verse.
- गायन (नः) 1. *m.* A singer ; a gossip. *n.* A singing. *a.* Singing.
- गारिच (चः) 1. *m.* Rice.
- गारुड (डः) 1. *m.* Gold ; a charm against poison ; an emerald.
- गारुडिक (कः) 1. *m.* A charmer.
- गारुडी (डी) 3. *f.* Hogweed.
- गारुत्मत् (त) 1. *n.* The emerald.
- गार्गी (गौः-गौं-गौं) *a.* Born of *Garga*.
- गार्गक (कं) 1. *n.* A multitude of the descendants of the sage *Garga*.
- गार्गी.पुत्रकायनि (निः) 2. *m.* A descendant of the son of *Garga*.
- गार्ग्य्य (ग्य्यः-ग्य्यं-ग्य्यं) *a.* Of *Garga*.
- गार्ह (हः) 1. *m.* Desire ; an arrow. *a.* Of a vulture ; greedy.
- गार्ह.पत्र (त्रः) 1. *m.* An arrow.
- गार्ह.पत्र (त्रः) 1. *m.* *Idem*.
- गार्ह्य्य (र्य्यं) *a.* Of a vulture.
- गार्भ (भः-भी-भं) *a.* Uterine.
- गार्भिक (कः-को-कं) *a.* *Idem*.
- गार्भिण (णं) 1. *m.* A number or assemblage of pregnant women.
- गार्भिण्य्य (ण्य्यं) 1. *n.* *Idem*.
- गार्ह.पत्य (त्यः) 1. *m.* A sacred fire always kept burning by a householder, and transmitted to others.
- गार्हस्थ्य्य (स्थ्य्यं) 1. *n.* Order, state, or condition of a house-holder.
- गारु (रुः) 1. *m.* Flowing ; flux.
- गारुन (नं) 1. *n.* Straining ; fusing.
- गारुव (वः) 1. *m.* A tree the bark of which is used in dying (*Symplocos racemosa*) ; a sage.
- गारुलि (लिः) 2. *m.* A curse.
- गारुलित (तः-ता-तं) *p.* Dropped ; strained ; melted ; decayed ; lost.
- गारुलिन् (ली-लिनी-लि) *a.* Fusing, distilling ; abusing. *f.* Gesticulation.
- गारुलोच्य (च्यं) 1. *n.* Lotus seed.
- गार्ह (ह, उ) गार्हते 1. *d.* To churn. With अच to immerse, to bathe ; with वि to bathe, to agitate.
