दुराचार (रः-रा-रं) *a.* Wicked, base in conduct. *m.* Wickedness.
दुराद्य (द्यः-द्या-द्यं) *a.* Poor, not rich.
दुराद्यकर (रः-रा-रं) *a.* Making poor.
दुराद्यन्भव (वः-वा-वं) *a.* Of the poor.
दुरात्मन् (त्मा-त्मा-त्म) *a.* Vile, base.
